Any safe ammunition, no tracers \$25.00 entry fee. Lunch provided
Not Allowed – shooting jackets or mitts, shooting slings, spotting scopes or sighting shots

Stage2: 300 yds – Captain Carrie Trophy
Stage3: 200 yds – The Tramway Trophy

Partington Challenge Cup
15 rounds maximum , 1 minute, prone at 200 yds

City of Nelson Challenge Shield

3 member teams, geographical where possible
3 shots each, for combined score
\$3.00 entry per shooter
Prize money divided 3:2:1 ratio for 1st, 2nd, and 3rd placings

This match has a unique history. The trophies are from the early 1900's. The Interior of British Columbia Rifle Association originally sponsored the event. The last match of the era was in 1914. All trophies were lost when the men joined and went overseas in the 1st World War. The first trophy was recovered from a second hand store in Salmo. The others came back from diverse places as far away as Edmonton.

Fred Watson Memorial Match

Fred Watson Memorial Trophy
any rifle of military caliber in use by 1945.
10 rounds, 10 minutes, prone 200 yds with iron sights

NOT ALLOWED: micrometer sights, shooting jackets, shooting slings, shooting mitts, spotting scopes, sighting shots

Trophies and medals are presented at the end of the shoot. The trophies are kept at the Nelson clubhouse because of their rarity and value. Names of winners will be applied to trophies and presented again at the club banquet in April.
