

Indoor Range Policy



1. All persons using the indoor range must:
 - ☆ Be aware of the range safety rules
 - ☆ Follow these safety rules
2. The Indoor Range is open for members only, except for:
 - ☆ Club sanctioned events and programs
 - ☆ One-time guests of club members, for which a fee of five (\$5) dollars must be paid (Please pay using the form and box provided)
 - ☆ Guests of club members from another club with reciprocal membership privileges
 - ☆ Junior's being introduced to shooting sports
 - ☆ Authorized rentals, where proof of liability insurance has been provided
3. In the event of a stray shot at the Indoor Range a written report of the event will be provided to the member of the executive responsible for the Indoor Range at the earliest possible opportunity. Any discipline required will be at the discretion of the Range Committee or the Club Executive.
4. The range may not be used with firearms, during the time specified, for the event that is going on upstairs. You may use firearms only during set-up or take-down of upstairs rental facility. Non firearm uses are unrestricted if the upstairs is rented.
 - ☆ In the event of a firearm related injury, all possible help will be rendered to the injured person. If necessary the following must be contacted in order:
 - ☆ Ambulance Services (352-2112)
 - ☆ The Nelson City Police must be informed (911)
 - ☆ The Club President
 - ☆ Chairman of the Range Committee
5. All persons present at the time of injury **MUST** remain at the scene until the injured party receives medical aid. All parties present at the time of the injury must also have their name recorded.
6. Please leave the contacting of the family to the authorities. All persons involved will make themselves available for a special meeting of the executive, to be called by the President at the earliest opportunity, prior to the next General Meeting.
7. Members using the range **MUST** legibly sign the log provided. The log and clipboard are posted at the entrance. We are required to keep legible records for a minimum of six years.
8. Indoor range key Protocol:
 - ☆ Key holders must be certified range officers only
 - ☆ Loaning of keys is NOT permitted
10. **A violation of the above rules may be answered with a loss of privileges.**
