P.A.L. (Possession & Acquisition License) – Canadian Firearms Safety

This certificate is required to possess, purchase, transfer ownership, sell, or trade a firearm, as well as to purchase ammunition.

Non-Restricted: Sat/Sun, Mar 10 & 11, 9:00am-5:00pm. \$99. Crescent Valley Hall. Restricted: Sun Mar 11, 12:00pm-5:00pm. \$65. Crescent Valley Hall.

C.O.R.E (Conservation & Outdoor Recreation Education) Certificate:

This program is mandatory for those wishing to obtain a BC Hunting License. The purpose of the program is to ensure that hunters meet acceptable standards of knowledge & skill for a safe and responsible hunting season. **Sat/Sun, Oct 22 & 23, 9:00am-5:00pm. \$135. Crescent Valley Hall**

Canadian Firearms Safety Course: Restricted Firearms

Location: Salmo Recreation Center, Salmo BC

This course is required to obtain your Restricted Possession and Acquisition License (RPAL). Prerequisite: A Non-Restricted Firearms License. There is an additional fee for the Government office when paperwork is submitted. Pick up your manual for pre-reading before class. Must be 18 years of age or older.

MAPLESEED - JUNE 28, 2018

Project Mapleseed is a non-profit, 100% volunteer run organization committed to

helping preserve Canada's firearms heritage by delivering safe and effective rifle marksmanship training to Canadians in one-day marksmanship clinics called "Mapleseeds". Project Mapleseed uses a 25meter distance and scaled targets to simulate engaging targets from 100-400 yards in standing, sitting/kneeling and prone positions. We follow a strict curriculum that breaks down the fundamentals into its key components, starting with range safety and safe firearms handling. The

objective of the course is to develop the basic rifle marksmanship skills needed to effectively engage a 4 MOA target reliably in prone position.

The day starts at 7:00am and runs to 5:30pm. The final third

of the day is spent in practical exercises and in shooting marksmanship qualification tests. Participants who score 210 or more out of a possible 250 earns the shooter a Project Mapleseed Rifleman patch!


Eighth Annual West Kootenay Gun and Antiques Show




