

## **Outdoor Gun Range:**

**Notice to outdoor range user's:** Due to current and expected wildfire risk Nelson District Rod & Gun Club has implemented additional restrictions for the rifle, trap and archery ranges at the Barrett Creek property on Porto Rico Road.

- 1. The use of binary (exploding) targets (i.e. Tannerite or equivalent) are prohibited. (permanent restriction)
- 2. The use of tracer ammunition is prohibited.
- 3. The use of steel jacketed single projectiles will be prohibited.
- 4. Smoking is restricted to areas of concrete, gravel, or bare mineral soil, no smoking where there are organic materials or vegetation.

NDR&GC has struck the 3-person Fire Risk Working Group as described in the Fire Risk Policy to consider and implement additional precautionary restrictions and procedures, up to and including closing the ranges, to address the increasing wildland fire risk.

Nelson Rod & Gun Club Fire Risk Working Group recommends, in addition to the mandatory restrictions above, the following best practice at the Outdoor Range:

- Shooting be conducted between 7:30 am and 12:00 pm each day.

**Indoor Gun Range:** The indoor range will be closed on Sept. 12<sup>th</sup> as the hall is rented.

#### **Bill C-71**

A question was raised on the NRGC Facebook page regarding Bill C-71. I directed the question to **Richard Green**, the club's political firearms rep. Here is his response.

During the last federal election campaign Justin Trudeau promised to enact stricter gun control measures and he has not yet done so – but he did introduce Bill C-71 which contains a number of provisions designed only to

further harass legal gun owners. It has not yet reached third reading but will do so when the House of Commons reconvenes this fall.

There has been plenty of informed discussion by lobby organizations, media pundits, and editorials about the useless nature of the proposed legislation. However, the government politicians have, to their discredit, spouted numerous misleading arguments - whether due to ignorance or to a desire to pretend to be doing something about gang violence only the Public Safety Minister and the Prime Minister can testify.

The most damaging statement was made by Minister Goodale when he introduced the bill. He claimed there had been a 60% increase in gun crimes in the five years 2013 to 2018. He selected the year 2013 for a benchmark because it happened to be a year of unusual lack of gun violence. In fact, 2013 had the lowest level of gun violence since the early 1960's. Compared to other recent years since 2000 no such increase can be seen according to Statistics Canada. This deception has been pointed out by the CBC, the Globe and Mail, and many others.

Ah yes, Stats Canada. The federal government, a few police chiefs, and a few big-city mayors have recently claimed that a large portion — even more than 50% - of the guns used in crimes have been sourced locally from legal firearms owners; in some cases, by burglary and in others by clandestine purchases. These claims are not supported by evidence since — according to both the RCMP and Stats Canada — no records are kept of the source of guns used in crimes.

In an apparent effort to swell the numbers, it is common practice for any gun found at or near the scene of a crime to be labelled a "crime gun" whether it was involved or not. The person(s) involved in committing the crime do not need to be aware of the gun's presence! This is according to Stats Canada and would be considered very dishonest by any sane person.

If you would like to have efforts made to reduce gang crimes, then please take a few minutes to contact your Member of Parliament to let him know that you are not happy to have legal firearms owners further harassed while gangs are ignored. He is aware of the above misdirection by the federal government and he should have sufficient integrity to stand up and say so in the House of Commons. Demand that he do so! He is our representative!
