



# **NEWS: Time is running out for Early Payment Incentive for Renewing Members**

Once again, the Club is offering an incentive for early payment of memberships for those members who paid in 2018 and are renewing their memberships in 2019.

If you pay **between October 1**<sup>st</sup> **and November 30**<sup>th</sup> **2018** for 2019, there will be a reduction of \$10.00 Individuals and Seniors will pay \$75.00 Families will pay \$100.00
