PAL/RPAL/CORE:

PAL/RPAL/CORE courses

The Nelson District Rod & Gun Club is again sponsoring a suite of training courses for folks interested in the safe handling of firearms and/or hunting.

The Canadian Firearms Safety Course (PAL for unrestricted long rifles and shotguns and RPAL for restricted firearms like pistols) will be offered during the period January 15 - 23, 2022. These are one day courses with a minimum age of 12 years old. Safe handling of all common firearms and safe shooting techniques are taught. Cost \$125 for PAL and \$90 for RPAL. Classes limited to 12 persons per instructor. The September 19, 2021 RPAL course is 2/3rds full but remaining seats are only available to students that already have the PAL prerequisite.

Please note the new low price of \$90 for RPAL. This is in keeping with our commitment to be the least cost provider in the community.

The Conservation and Outdoor Recreation Education (CORE) two-day course includes practical firearms handling and a written examination on conservation ethics, Indigenous peoples and hunting in BC, BC law and regulations, first aid and survival, firearms safety and animal and bird identification. This course is required to obtain a hunting licence. Minimum age is 10 years old. Course cost is \$150 and will be offered January 29-30.

These courses will follow the current written COVID-19 provincial orders on the date of the training. If interested in either the training or hall rentals call Alan Bond at 250 352-2289

NDR&GC welcomes Elections Canada

Despite how you feel about the prime minister calling a snap election, as not all of us agree it is an appropriate time, the club and potentially some members, will or can benefit from the writ being dropped.

First off, Elections Canada is renting/leasing the Mickey McEwen Memorial Hall for part or all of 22 days. This represents a game changer for hall rentals and club income to keep costs down for members. The hall is being used for training, Advanced Polls as well as the September 20 General Election. The club will still not achieve an average rental income this year but at least it won't be the disaster that seemed to be looming.

There is also an employment opportunity for interested members, family and friends. Elections Canada offers employment opportunities for working at the polls during an election. Notice to holders of firearms licences

You should have recently received a letter from the RCMP detailing changes in the conditions applicable to your licence. That letter must be kept with your licence. The changed conditions are already in effect. Specifically, if you are planning to transport your restricted and/or prohibited firearms:

- to a port of exit in order to take them outside of Canada and from a port of entry; or
- to and from a gun show; or
- to and from a business with a licence to repair and/or appraise restricted or prohibited firearms; or
- to and from any place a peace officer, firearms officer, or chief firearms officer is located for verification, registration or disposal.

then you must apply for an Authorization to Transport to your Chief Firearms Officer. The phone number to call is 1-800-731-4000.

You will notice that these conditions are a return to the conditions that were in force several years ago. It continues to be permissible to transport restricted firearms and/or prohibited handguns (12(6.1) handguns) for the purpose of target practice to and from all shooting clubs and approved ranges.

It also continues to be permissible to transport newly acquired restricted and/or prohibited firearms to your home by a reasonably direct route.

If you did not receive the abovementioned letter, then you should take steps to have one sent to you. It will contain your name, address, firearms licence number, and expiry date.


