DO NOT ENTER THE HALL IF YOU:


- ARE PRESENTLY IN SELF-ISOLATION/ QUARANTINE DUE TO TRAVEL HISTORY OR YOU HAVE BEEN TOLD TO SELF ISOLATE BY PUBLIC HEALTH.
- HAVE ANY NEW OR WORSENING SYMPTOMS OF COVID – 19; FEVER OR CHILLS, COUGH OR SORE THROAT, EXTREME FATIGUE, BODY ACHES, DIARRHEA, DIFFICULTY BREATHING, PINK EYE, LOSS OF TASTE OR SMELL, LOSS OF APPETITE, HEADACHE, NAUSEA OR VOMITING.
- HAD A POSTIVE OR INCONCLUSIVE COVID- 19 TEST RESULT IN THE LAST 14 DAYS, OR YOU ARE CURRENTLY AWAITING TEST RESULTS. YOU MAY ANSWER “NO” TO THIS SCREENING QUESTION IF YOU HAVE BEEN CLEARED TO RETURN TO WORK BY PUBLIC HEALTH OR A MEDICAL PROFESSIONAL.

STUDENTS ARE EXPECTED TO BRING AND WEAR MASKS WHEN ATTENDING ANY COURSES DURING PHO RESTRICTIONS

Course particulars

NDR&GC strives to be the least cost provider in consideration of the club's commitment to community support. Our PAL RPAL and CORE courses are the lowest rates and there is no requirement to purchase manuals for any of the courses. PAL and RPAL are available as free downloads off the internet and we have loaner CORE manuals (while supply lasts) or any course manuals may be purchased from BCWF.

CORE manuals are \$20 plus GST and shipping from BCWF. The PAL and RPAL courses use the same manual - Canadian Firearms Safety Course which you can also purchase from BCWF (\$30 + GST and shipping) or free download online.



PAL: Possession and Acquisition Licence

Minimum Age 12.

One day course: 8:00am -5:00pm, plus testing time

Learn safe handling of all common firearms, and safe shooting techniques. Test at the end of the day.

Maximum 12 students per instructor.

RPAL: Restricted Possession and Acquisition Licence

Prerequisite: Non restricted Firearms

Minimum Age: 18

One day Course: 9:00am – 1:00pm (4 hours plus testing time, if all students have completed a recent PAL course. If students PAL is dated, 6 hours.)

Maximum 12 students per instructor

CORE: Conservation and Outdoor Recreation Education

Minimum Age 10

Two-day course: 1st day 8:00am -4:00pm

Second day will be shorter for students with a valid PAL

Conservation and Outdoor Recreation Education. Includes practical firearms handling test and a written examination. Written exam includes: conservation, ethics, law and regulations, first aid and survival, firearm safety and animal and bird identification, indigenous peoples & hunting in BC

It is recommended for students to review the manual before coming to class.
