SHEEP FEEDING PROGRAM

With the arrival of spring means the end of the sheep feeding program for another year. Compared to other years, this was an easier winter for all wildlife, including the sheep. We had a total of 13 sheep at the feeding site over the winter months.

Sadly, we lost two sheep to vehicle incidents, one ewe and an older broomed full curl ram. We were able to obtain a permit from the province to retain the horns of this ram and have commissioned Lino Grifone to do a mount. We are looking forward to the finished product.

On a happier note, this year we had 3 lambs at the feed site. Typically, we see one or two lambs during our feeding program, so an extra one is a step in the right direction.
